The Mental Health Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) is an outpatient department of Union General Hospital.

Licensed Mental Health Professionals provide individual, group, and family therapy based on an individualized treatment plan under the supervision of a Board-Certified Psychiatrist. The program is operated four days per week, Monday-Thursday.



The IOP provides a relaxed, comfortable setting where patients are encouraged to participate in group psychotherapy to promote achievement in their individualized treatment goals.
